I recognize the challenges and inconveniences jurors face in order to serve so our office is always looking to improve the jury service experience. As part of our expanded online services, you can now pre-register online on our jury webpage (www.hcdistrictclerk.com/jury). You will receive a confirmation email with all the information you need for your day of service. And a reminder email and/or text the day prior to your service.

In addition, you can claim disqualifications and exemptions online without having to go to the courthouse. Our office also allows jurors to re-print their jury summons from our website, which can be used to get a free ride on METRO buses and METROrail by simply presenting their dated summons.

Next time you receive a jury summons, think about all the citizens you could be helping by simply responding to it. While you may not be called to serve on a high profile murder trial or one that makes the news, you could serve in the trial of a business like your very own, deliberating an issue that affects people like yourself, your neighbors, or your community as a whole.
